

Data Privacy Policy

What student and parent data the School holds, why it is held, who it is shared with, and how a parent can review it.

The School holds personal data because admission, Government reporting and Board registration require it — and for no other reason.

What we hold

CNIC copies of parents, the child's B-Form details, registered contact numbers, attendance, academic results and behaviour records.

Why we hold it

Solely for admission, PEF and Government of Punjab reporting, BISE Multan registration where applicable, and internal record-keeping.

Who it is shared with

Records are not shared with any third party except where required by PEF, the Government of Punjab, BISE Multan or another competent authority, or with the written consent of the parent.

Photographs and social media

The School may photograph students during activities and events and use the material on its official pages and website. A parent who does not wish this may submit a written opt-out to the Principal's Office at any time; it is honoured for all future material.

Reviewing your child's record

A parent may request to review the record held in respect of their child by submitting a written request to the Principal's Office.
